Values	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Show courtesy to all students, teachers and community members • Cooperate with others • Resolve conflict respectfully, calmly, fairly and biblically • Develop positive and respectful relationships and think about the effect on relationships before acting • Comply with the school's uniform policy or dress code • Take personal responsibility for behaviour and actions • Take care with property
Engagement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attend school every day (unless legally excused) • Arrive at school and class on time • Be prepared for every lesson • Model and follow class rules • Actively participate in learning • Aspire and strive for the highest standards in learning
